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<u>The transmission of the first lesson and any materials</u> to any student within seven days after the institution accepts the student for admission. You are not eligible for protection from the STRF and you are not required to pay the STRF assessment, if either of the following applies:

The state of California created the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic losses suffered by students in educational program who are California residents, or are enrolled in a residency programs attending certain schools regulated by the Bureaus for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education.

You may be eligible for STRF if you are a California resident or are enrolled in a residency program, prepaid tuition, paid the STRF assessment, and suffered an economic loss as a result of any of the following:

- 1. The school closed before the course of instruction was completed.
- The school's failure to pay refunds or charges on behalf of a student to a third party for license fees or any other purpose, or to provide equipment or materials for which a charge was collected within 180 days before the closure of the school.
- 3. The school's failure to pay or reimburse loan proceeds under a federally guaranteed student loan program as required by law or to pay or reimburse proceeds received by the school prior to closure in excess of tuition and other costs.
- 4. There was a material failure to comply with the Act or this Division within 30 days before the school closed or, if the material failure began earlier than 30 days prior to closure, the period determined by the Bureau.
- 5. An inability after diligent efforts to prosecute, prove, and collect on a judgment against the institution for a violation of the Act.

TUITION REFUND POLICY

The institution shall refund the unused portion of tuition fees and other charges if the student does not register for the period of attendance or withdraws there from at any time prior to completion of the course, or otherwise fails to complete the period of enrollment. The institutional refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course of instruction shall be a pro rata refund.

The refund shall be calculated as follows:

- 1. Deduct a registration fee.
- 2. Divide this figure by the number of hours in the program.
- 3. The quotient is the hourly charge for the program.
- 4. The amount owed by the student for the purpose of calculation a refund is derived by multiplying the total hours attended by the hourly charge for instruction plus the amount of the registration fee specified in paragraph (1).
- 5. The refund shall be any amount in excess of the figure derived in paragraph (4) that was paid by the student.

TUITION REFUNDS; TIME FOR PAYMENT

The institution shall pay refunds due on a reasonable or timely basis, not to exceed 30 days following the date upon which the student's withdrawal has been determined.

For example, if a student decides to withdraw from a theory class (45 hours) after attending 10 hours, the refund would be 35 hours times the rate of \$7.78 per hour = \$272.30. If a student decides to withdraw at any time prior to completion from a field training course, the entire tuition will be refunded.
